

**Requirements for Food Vendors
2008 Labor & Ethnic Heritage Festival**

1. Food Vendors may only sell food items previously agreed to in the vendor application form.
2. Food Vendors must obtain a Health Department certification in advance of the Festival.
3. Food Vendors must provide copies of their current Rhode Island Sales Tax Permit and Rhode Island Food Business License.
4. Vendors must display prices for items being sold.
5. Vendors must supply and set up their own equipment, including tables, propane, electricity, etc. Set up must be completed by 11:30 am.
6. Vendors must use sound baffling if they use a generator.
7. Vendors must dispose of trash in the appropriate receptacles.
8. Vendors may not dispose of grease from cooking done at Slater Mill. You must carry it away from the site.
9. Food Vendors will be provided a 12'x12' space on the grounds. The Festival will not provide shelter.
10. Vendors must break down their equipment at the conclusion of the Festival (to be completed no later than 6:00pm).
11. In the event of bad weather, the Festival will make every attempt to accommodate the Vendor inside. However, the Festival is not obligated to move the Vendor indoors.
12. Vendors must cancel at least 4 weeks prior to the Festival to receive a full refund of the registration fee.
13. Registration fee of \$50.00 is due by Saturday, August 23, 2008.
